We conducted extensive research on the subject of teaching .The Direct Method gives the student the ability to communicate quickly because she is encouraged to be creative during practice. It gives, by far, the widest range of capability to understand what another person says to you and in developing your captivity to speak. This is the method of choice for instruction with a live trainer and speaking and listening are most important. The Grammar-Translation method requires the learner to spend a lot of time Understanding the language structure. Listening and speaking suffer because of this. Understanding the structure is helpful in reading and particularly in writing. Grammar And vocabulary are emphasized throughout. This is the method of choice when the Student's goal is to achieve a high level of writing and reading ability in a foreign Language, versus speaking and listening. The Audio-Lingual Method also allows the learner to communicate quickly but Within the limited range that the repetition allows. It improves comprehension only if speaker uses phrases that the learner has studied. Reading is limited, and an Understanding of how to use the language is very limited. This is the method that is isen when a live trainer is not available. To conclude the key strategies for teaching English classes are Probably developing a positive and collaborative working atmosphere and providing a variety of work suitable for different levels. We have to say, that practically it is impossible to use one method or approach solely when aiming to teach a second language successfully. Lessons should be designed with effective methods of teaching. In this wayw, we will achieve more success in learning English.

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
